President's Message

Hi Orchid Lovers,

The DBOS Board of Trustees and I are looking forward to seeing many of you at the Deerfield Beach Orchid Society meeting **in person** at 7:30 pm on Tuesday, June 8 at the Woman's Club of Deerfield Beach. It will be the first inperson meeting since March 2020. Our speakers will be Segundo and Yolanda Cuesta from Quest Orchids speaking

on "Growing Cattleyas and Their Relatives in South Florida." They will provide orchids from their beautiful collection for the raffle table as well as provide orchids to sell. After over a year of not having monthly meetings, it will be fun to add a new orchid or two to our collections. Yolanda and Segundo grow mostly Cattleyas, Vandas, and some Dendrobium species in a 50,000 square foot growing area. They have graciously welcomed the DBOS members who have visited their greenhouse on numerous occasions during our bus trips to the Homestead area. We hope to resume our annual bus trips sometime in 2022.

We will also have a hobbyist table so carefully look through your collection to bring some of your lovely orchids to share with all of us. We will not have our usual food table. We are providing small bottles of water and some packaged snacks for our members and guests. We are requesting that you bring and wear your mask. You may want to bring a beach towel to throw over your chair if that makes you feel more comfortable. You might want to bring your own water bottle. Other organizations have been holding meetings at the Woman's Club for several months, and we want you to feel comfortable in your surroundings.

Our June speaker, Tim Culbertson, provided an outstanding Zoom meeting for our members. Tim's passion for plants and his great experience in working with orchids was apparent throughout the presentation. He has worked at Longwood Gardens in Philadelphia and tended orchids at the Smithsonian Institution and the United States National Arboretum, where he collected rare plants and documented cultivated species and hybrids for their herbarium. He discussed Encyclias of Mexico and Beyond and had numerous photos of the showy flowers and made us wish we could enjoy the fragrances. He discussed the ease of growth and provided an order list of Encyclias for DBOS members. We will have a printed out copy of the Encyclias that he is offering to DBOS members for you to review, and a Gmail will be sent to you with a link to it. Tim is requesting that all final orders be received by June 28. He will either ship your orchids to you directly, and/or as a part of a package that he will send to one of our DBOS Board of Trustees who will bring your orchids to the July 13 DBOS meeting.

A huge thank you to the diligence and time-consuming efforts of DBOS Board member, Dennis Pearl, who has secured a venue for our annual picnic. Mark your calendar now for this popular, fun event that will be held Sunday, October 17 at Tradewinds Park in the Fritillary shelter. Additional information will be provided closer to the event.

June in Your Orchid Collection

June is the most dramatically tropical month in South Florida. As the southeast Trade Winds blow cool moist air off the Gulf Stream daily, as surely the heating effect of the center of the peninsula percolates up massive thunder heads. The increased cloud cover drawing a veil across the afternoon sun provides much cooling relief for our plants late in the day. Because of this additional cloud cover, our plants are less stressed than in the brightest of May sunshine. The increased humidity makes June feel hotter to us, but this humidity brings blessed balm to our plants from the unrelentingly dry heat of late spring. The shading clouds are also the harbinger of the almost daily rains that arrive like clockwork with the thunderstorms that re-circulate the moisture laden air back toward the ocean in the afternoon. These showers can drop the temperature 10-12 degrees in almost no time, again bring our plants relief when they need it most in the peak heat of the day. In June, such soaking rains that can sometimes be an inch or more an hour, are the norm rather than the exception. For orchids grown outside in South Florida this month, how to dry them out becomes more the question than how or when to water them. For most sympodial genera (cattleyas, dendrobiums, oncidiums, etc.) the natural rainfall of June is sufficient. Only in those rare once or twice times during June when no rain falls for nearly a week is it necessary to think of watering sympodial orchids in June. Even then it usually is a thought that can be dismissed. A thorough, "hard" drying in this first month of the rainy season is usually of much more overall value to sympodial orchids than the slight extra push of additional water. Harder plants that have not been pushed with extra water are much more disease resistant than softer more lushly grown orchids. Vandas and other high water requirement plants may still need periodic watering in June but remember that these types too relish occasional "hard" drying and the heavy often lingering, rains of June are just the nostrum for re-hydrating them even when they have become as dry as the cork in a wine bottle dry. When watering in June, remember at no season is the standard 'water early in the day' rule more relevant; those extra hours of drying are crucial. If your vandas or other orchids really need water, water early in the morning to allow time for them to dry not merely by night but by the time the all too likely afternoon thunderstorms arrive to soak them again. Be sure when you water that the roots of the vandas are saturated until they turn overall dark green. This will still take two applications of water spaced a few minutes apart. June is the archetypical month for careful but totally thorough watering. For those of us committed to sloth, this month is one in which benign neglect becomes a




