Hope this message finds you all well and enjoying the great outdoors during this time of confinement. Getting out amongst my orchids and taking care of them has been a real blessing. I have done a lot of potting and mounting of orchids during the last several weeks and my supplies are running low. If you are running out of supplies, a few of our DBOS friends and long-time supporters have solutions to these problems.

We are not encouraging you to leave your homes and take any unnecessary chances. In an abundance of caution, the DBOS Board cancelled the June DBOS members' meeting in addition to the May meeting. We checked with a representative from the Woman's Club of Deerfield Beach, where we hold our monthly meetings, and they are unsure as to whether they will be able to be open and available to hold meetings in June. Since Jim Roberts from Florida SunCoast Orchids was coming over from the West Coast of Florida, we are rescheduling him for later in the year. At this writing, South Florida residents still advised to stay home for a bit longer and practice social distancing.

Schomburgkia's are a favorite of mine. I still call them Schoms. They are mounted on wood and on every tree in my yard—no matter what kind of tree it is. Presently, there are spikes everywhere and some blooming. The Schomburgkia grandiflora used to be Schom. tibicinis, but one of my two orchid mentors, Vince Dicks, informed me that a decision was made that they are different. The lips on grandiflora are rounded and elongated on tibicinis. The member species of Schomburgkia have been moved to different genera: Myrmecophila and Laelia are two. The C. loddigesii x Mcp. brysiana didn't take much of the characteristics from the Schom. as it looks very much like the cattleya. If anyone knows the name of the beautiful NOID Schomburgkia/Myrmecophila/Laelia below, please let me know as the squirrels absconded with the tag! Need new tags to keep up! Off to Green Barn!

By the way, my other orchid mentor is Grace Holliday!

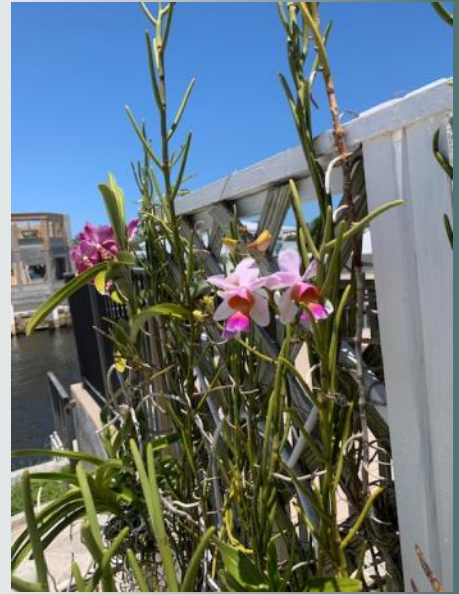


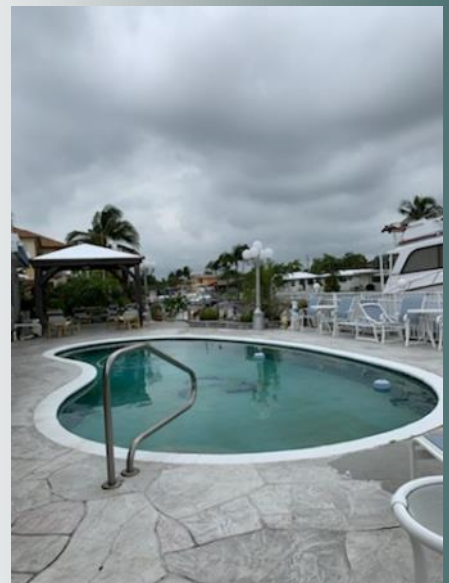












Renew Your DBOS Membership for 2020

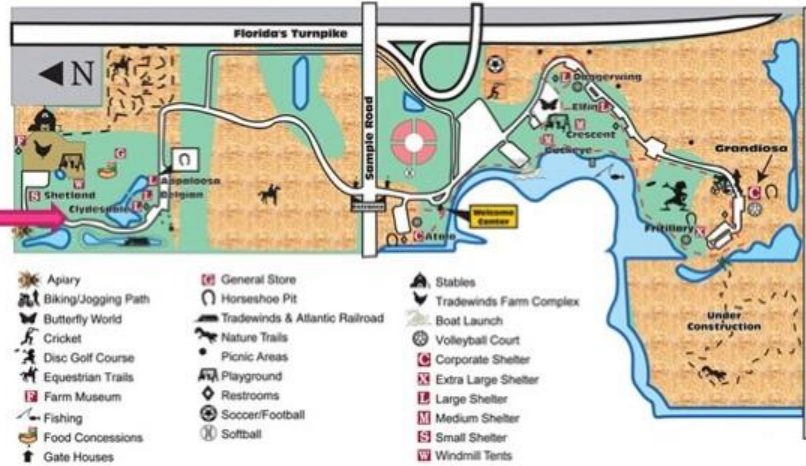
