Hope to see you all on Tuesday and as always, bring a friend...Vince



Speaker of the Month

Chuck McCartney

Chuck McCartney's family moved to southern Dade County, Florida, in 1918. He was raised in Homestead and became familiar with orchids as a child because his uncle was a hobby grower and friend of legendary orchid grower and explorer Freddie Fuchs. In fact, his family has been friends with the orchid-growing Fuchs family across 3 generations. Chuck graduated from high school with Bob Fuchs, now of the world-famous R.F. Orchids, and they remain friends to this day.

In 1984, Chuck joined the staff of the American Orchid Society as assistant editor of the society's publications when the organization moved its national headquarters to West Palm Beach. He eventually became editor of the AOS Bulletin and the Awards Quarterly. In 1990, Chuck was hired as a copy editor with The Miami Herald's former Broward Edition, which served the Fort Lauderdale area. He retired in 2009 and continues to live in Hollywood.

Chuck has written extensively about orchids for numerous publications, including the American Orchid Society Bulletin (now Orchids), England's Orchid Review, the California-based Orchid Digest, the North American Native Orchid Journal, The Native Orchid Conference Journal and the Fairchild Tropical Garden Bulletin. He also has written about orchids and other wildflower topics for The Florida Naturalist and Palmetto, the magazine of the Florida Native Plant Society.

His special interest is the native orchids of southern Florida, and for more than 20 years, he has explored the pinelands, hammocks, swamps and mangrove forests of the Keys, Everglades National Park and the Big Cypress Swamp in search of our native orchids. He has found and photographed most of the 60 species reported to be native to the southern end of the state. During these hikes, he also photographs the beautiful (and sometimes not so beautiful) wildflowers he encounters.

Chuck also has studied orchids and other wildflowers in the mountains of western North Carolina, where he owns a small summer cabin, and he has written about the orchids of that region.

In addition to his magazine articles, Chuck speaks frequently to orchid societies, native plant societies, garden clubs, and natural history groups about the orchids and other wildflowers of South Florida and the Southern Appalachians, illustrating these programs, first with color slides and now with digital images. His lectures have taken him to 16 Florida counties and to three other states.

Chuck is a longtime member of both the American Orchid Society and the Florida Native Plant Society, and he recently officially joined the Fort Lauderdale Orchid Society.
