Plant Table Registration Instructions

- 2. Absolutely NO INSECTS.
- 3. Your orchid must have a name.
- 4. It must be in the correct category. (Ask if you don't know.)
- 5. PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY the name of the Orchid and your name on the Registration Form.
- 6. Try to place your plant in an attractive container to enhance the orchids beauty.
- 7. Plants must be on the table before judging starts.
- PLANTS NOT MEETING THESE CRITERIA MAY BE DISQUALIFIED FROM JUDGING.

I hope you all had as much fun as I had in planning this, my first ever bus trip, for you. Thank you for your support.




