Hello Everyone,

It's July and boy is it hot! July tends to have a similar weather pattern as June although the storms tend to be shorter in duration, with a hotter drying period each day. This is good for your potted orchids as the media will dry more thoroughly which helps you fight off fungus.

Make sure you don't overwater your orchids in media (pots) as this will foster fungal growth. It is also very important to include potassium nitrate and Epsom salts in your fertilizer (20-20-20) weekly to promote healthy growth. Enjoy July and your collection of orchids!

Don't forget our upcoming bus trip to the Homestead, Florida orchid growers. It is almost sold out and it will be a great event. Janet Lamborn


International Account Manager, Plant Pathogen Diagnostics Orchid & Hosta Diagnostic Specialist

"Don't put on the virus blinders, your collection is depending on you"


Janet Lamborn has been involved in the plant diagnostic industry for over seventeen years at Agdia, Inc. Starting in Agdia's Testing Services Laboratory, she gained considerable knowledge of the crops received in the lab, including orchids.

After several years in Testing Services, Janet moved into the Sales and Marketing department. She works closely with Agdia's international customers and manages Agdia' Distributor Program. She also works closely with Agdia's specialty crop groups such as orchid societies, making sure members and hobbyists understand what they should be testing for and the options that are available.

In this talk, "Don't put on the virus blinders, your collection is depending on you". We're going to look closely at each viral pathogen, what it looks like and how it's transmitted. We will also talk about sanitation practices, testing options and what to do with those results.

Topic: Orchid Basics

Newcomers to orchids will learn how to choose the correct plants for their growing area and what they need - water, light, fertilizer, temperature, so they grow and flower beautifully. Start your journey into the exciting

July 14

Topic: Orchid Repotting & Mounting Orchids

Learn how often an orchid should be repotted, about different potting medias, the proper type of pot or basket to use or how to mount orchids on items such as tree fern or cork. Demonstrations will be given.

July 21

Topic: Training your eye—Orchid Pests & Diseases

Location: Exhibit Hall A

Learn about pests and diseases that harm orchids. From bacterial and fungal rots to insects, such as thrips, scale, snails and spider mites. Students will learn how to identify the culprits, what products to use to get rid of them, as well as what to do to avoid them in the future. This is information you need to know to grow the best orchids possible. Orchids or orchid leaves may be brought in for diagnosis, but must be placed in plastic bags to prevent contaminating other plants.
