President's Message

Hello orchid lovers!

Well June was an unusual month for weather. It started out extremely wet and rainy like May, and the last few weeks were extremely dry. I spent energy-sapping time outside watering my orchids not under a watering system during the extremely hot weather—even at 7:00 am when the humidity and heat were already brutal. Dr. Motes says, "The lack of rain has given our plants welcome relief from diseases that are ever present in our subtropical gardens. We now need to

take advantage of this opportunity to dry our plants hard. Water only when plants have become completely and thoroughly dry. Be sure to water with several applications of water spaced a few minutes apart. Then let plants dry thoroughly again." He also recommends that you apply liquid fertilizer instead of water during dry patches.

Follow Dr. Motes recommendations for hard drying for Vandas and other monopodial orchids; thrip control, which is always a threat when there are more than five days without rain; and, how mites might savage your soft cane Dendrobiums, Catasetums, Oncidiums, and Paphs. These tips and more are outlined in his books *Florida Orchid Growing: Month by Month* or *Florida Vanda Growing.* Dr. Motes suggest that this year without the rains that typically wash away the mites in June and July as well as the excessive heat, in order to control mites two sprayings 7-10 days apart are required. Control of mites is covered in *Florida Orchid Growing*.

We hope you enjoy/enjoyed (depending on when you read the newsletter) our July DBOS Virtual Meeting featuring Bill Thoms, a renowned orchid grower specializing in Bulbophyllums. Bill is a world traveler and nationally recognized speaker. It goes without saying that he is a knowledgeable, interesting and funny speaker.

Florida is seeing spikes in the cases of COVID-19 as I write this note to you. We will wait and see how things are for the August 11 meeting. Presently, we can begin face-to-face meetings at the Woman's Club of Deerfield Beach for our August meeting, and we are planning to do this. We will let you know if this changes and if we will need to hold another virtual meeting or a meeting on Zoom. The results of the Survey Monkey that we sent out a few weeks ago indicate that about 75 percent of the respondents would like to meet in person.

Jim Roberts, who leads Florida SunCoast Orchids, is our August speaker. Jim has been growing orchids for over 30 years in climates ranging from cold Minnesota to hot Southwest Florida. In search of orchid treasures, he has traveled extensively to locations in Hawaii, South America, and Europe, always seeking plants that will grow and bloom best for his clients. Jim's topic is *Summertime and the Growin' is Easy!* It highlights ways to grow orchids outside in the summer, which is mostly for South Florida folks, and it also applies to those who go back north over the summer.

We will keep you informed of other events scheduled for this fall as we have further information.

Bill is the only person to receive Awards of Quality for Bulbophyllum hybrids as well as receiving the hybridizer's dream; an Award of Distinction for a New Avenue of breeding. Many of his crosses are winning awards around the country. The AOS has just added a yearly award named for him for the best Bulbophyllum exhibited.

The talks are spiced with funny stories and funny associations so whether you grow thousands of orchids, only a few, or none at all, you will have a wonderfully entertaining time and be able to grow anything better. Many of the most important requirements for growing world class plants are made easy to understand and remember.

Don't miss this great opportunity to learn how to grow these fascinating plants and to hear one of the most knowledgeable, interesting and funny speakers in the orchid world.

Bill will include information in his presentation on how to get a signed copy of his new book, Bulbophyllums; the Incomplete Guide, From A to WHY?


