- 1. You must have owned your plant for at least 6 months.
- 2. Absolutely NO INSECTS.
- 3. Your orchid must have a name.
- 4. It must be in the correct category. (Ask if you don't know.)
- 5. PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY the name of the Orchid and your name on the Registration Form.
- 6. Try to place your plant in an attractive container to enhance the orchids beauty.
- 7. Plants must be on the table before judging starts.

PLANTS NOT MEETING THESE CRITERIA MAY BE DISQUALIFIED FROM JUDGING.

Orchid Tasks for June by Dr. Martin Motes

- Careful watering this month often means no watering at all. Arise early to enjoy the cool and water only when necessary.
- Space plants amply. Good air circulation is essential across the coming months.
- Repot Phals and Reset Vandas. Make sure plants are firmly set in their new abodes.
- Begin or continue a disease prevention program with prophylatic application of Thiophanate Methyl (Cleary's 3336) and Alliette or Banrot
- Cleanup growing area and plants. Remove dead leaves from plants and ground. Pull weeds.
- Prune trees and shrubs in increase air circulation.

The Ghost Orchid—A Fascinating Florida Native


