Hello Everyone,

We are now in June which is the official beginning of hurricane season. June brings with it an increase in humidity and rain. If you have been caring for your collection throughout the spring months by treating for fungus and pests along with making sure your plants are potted correctly and spaced for proper air circulation, you are off to a good start for the increase in rain associated with June. Continue to monitor and treat your

collection for pests and fungus as both will be more prevalent throughout the summer. It is very important to water/feed your collection EARLY in the day to allow proper drying out of the plant by the evening to prevent fungal rot. Try spacing your plants farther apart if you have the room to do so to allow better circulation (although if you are like me, any extra space means I need to buy another orchid). Enjoy all the new growth that comes with the humidity and afternoon rains of June!

This month, we have Fred Clarke of Sun Valley Orchids giving a wonderful talk on Catasetum, Cycnoches, and Mormons. These orchids are beautifully unusual in flower structure. If you aren't currently growing them, you should consider adding them to your collection. Come see Fred Clarke's talk and you will want to have them in your collection!

Our next event is our bus trip to the growers in September. It's always a great event. We leave early on Saturday and travel to growers on a luxury coach that has plenty of room for your purchases. Breakfast and lunch on the bus with plenty of beverages. Cocktails and hors d'oeuvres as well in the afternoon. A fantastic trip with fantastic people! Join us!

While you walk through and enjoy them start thinking about those special orchids you want to add and start saving your money for the annual DBOS bus trip on September 14, 2019. The trip is open to DBOS paid members. In August, we will see if any seats remain and open the trip to guests.

What a way to start the day with none other than "the Vanda Man!" If you have never visited Tony Romani at **R & R**Orchids in Loxahatchee, or if you have been here several times before, prepare for a feast for your eyes and take some of these stunning beauties home with you. Magnificently grown orchids in this orchid paradise for Vanda lovers!

Our next stop is **Odom's Orchids in Fort Pierce**, which specializes in Cattleya orchids, but also grow Phalaenopsis, Lady Slippers, Oncidiums, and many species from different genera. Most of their orchids are mature, blooming size plants so if you do not want to wait years for them to bloom be prepared to take a few home to enjoy!

Ready to add another beauty from **Krull-Smith Orchids in Apopka**? They are the leading orchid hybridizer in the world for award-quality show plants, having received over 700 quality and cultural awards from the American Orchid Society. You will find something here to love and take home with you from their highest quality species and hybrids of Phalaenopsis, Cattleya's, and Paphiopedilums as well as a wide array of novelty orchids such as Bulbophyllums.

We begin our journey back south with a stop at **Ritter Tropic 1 Orchids in Kissimmee**. After a great day of orchid hunting for those must-have orchids, we stop to see what final orchid treasures we can find from Linda Ritter and her daughter. Vanda's, Cattleya's, Dendrobium's, Encyclia's and more await you at this stop so find room to add a few more orchids!

Speaker of the Month Fred Clarke

Sunset Valley Or<u>chids</u>
June 11, 2019

"The Species of Catasetum, Cycnoches, and Mormodes and their Culture"

The species Catasetums, Mormodes and Cycnoches are reviewed, male and female flowers and a complete plant culture section. Catasetum, Cycnoches and Mormodes are three related genera from the Tribe Cymbidieae. Individually, each has been considered an orchid oddity, or "botanical", of interest mainly to the seriously addicted enthusiast. These plants have a brief deciduous period in winter, when the plants need a definite dry rest period bordering on neglect. These robust orchids are native to lowland tropical forests in Central and South Ameriintermediate and are usually grown in warm or conditions. ca

Fred Clarke has been growing orchids since 1977 and has been hybridizing for 35 of those years. With over 38 years as a professional grower and manager in the horticultural industry, Fred applies these skills at his orchid nursery; Sunset Valley Orchids, located in San Diego, California. He is a passionate orchid grower whose curiosity in orchids is broad and varied. Although developing Cattleya hybrids has been his sustaining interest, he is also actively creating new Catasetinae, Paphiopedilum and Australian Dendrobium hybrids.

His pioneering work in Catasetum intergeneric breeding has led to the development of several notable hybrids, most recently the grex, Fredclarkeara After Dark, which produced "the blackest flower ever witnessed". This grex has received eight FCC's, six AM's and the coveted 'Award of Distinction' on the first flowers shown for judging!

Fred is an internationally acclaimed speaker and travels extensively within USA, Canada, South America, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa. He is an accredited American Orchid Society Judge in the Pacific South region. His plants have received hundreds of quality awards from the American Orchid Society.


