President's Message

It is a busy time of the year for the Deerfield Beach Orchid Society (DBOS) members. A busload of us headed up north on September 14 and added to our collections. We appreciated the hospitality and beautiful orchids, as well as complimentary orchids for our raffle, at Odom's Orchids, Krull-Smith Orchids, and Ritter Tropic 1 Orchids. We also had an unplanned stop at First Orchid Nursery in Apopka that was a hit with members.

Andrea Niessen provided a delightful tour of Colombia and the orchid growing regions at our October monthly meeting. We saw images of beautiful scenery and amazing orchids growing in nature. Addition-

ally, she provided some gorgeous orchids for our raffle table and had some of her exquisite orchids for sale to members.

The DBOS 8th annual orchid show and sale, "Orchid Obsession", is rapidly approaching on November 16-17 at the Safe Schools Institute in Boca Raton. We have 10 orchid vendors and six, non-orchid vendors participating. Show hours are 10:00 am – 5:00 pm both days. Get ready for the holidays, save your money, and prepare to shop at Florida SunCoast Orchids, Krull-Smith Orchids, Mac's Orchids, Odom's Orchids, Orchids in Bloom, Quest Orchids, Ritter Tropic 1 Orchids, So Orchids, Soroa Orchids, and Springwater Orchids. Additionally, you will be able to purchase orchid supplies, jewelry, pottery, and artistic pieces. We welcome DBOS volunteers to help us at the show. Shifts are 9:00 am – 1:00 pm or 1:00 – 5:00 pm on both Saturday and Sunday. Please let us know if you are available to provide some time to assist the society.

Just a few weeks after the show, we will be holding our annual holiday party on Saturday, December 7 at the Croation American Social Club in Deerfield Beach from 6:00 - 10:00 pm. This is in place of our December meeting. Members of DBOS who attend the holiday party receive a beautiful FREE orchid. See further information about this in related article.

Due to the dry conditions and above average temperature in September and October, Thrips and mites may be a problem, so pay attention to your orchids to control both Thrips and mites. Dr. Martin Motes provides methods for controlling them in his Florida Orchid Growing. Ensure that your Vandas are getting enough water and fertilizer so they will produce beautiful blooms for you later. Many cattleyas, laelias, oncidiums and phalaenopsis-type dendrobiums finish their growths in October and should be hardened off with reduced water and fertilizer. Less frequent applications of 15-5-15 is a good strategy. Space these applications further apart at 10 to 12-day intervals. According to Dr. Motes, for "Orchids which are preparing for winter dormancy, extra care is required to ensure they stay dry and are weaned off fertilizer. The warmth may stimulate them to produce an off-season growth and to diminish their chance of flowering."

Speaker of the Month Chuck McCartney

November 12, 2019

Chuck McCartney grew up in Homestead, along with 3 generations of the orchidgrowing Fuchs family. In fact, orchids – including several of South Florida's native species – were the first flowers he remembers as a child, and he has been fascinated with them ever since.

He graduated from Florida State University in Tallahassee in 1969 with a bachelor's degree in English education and taught at Miami Central High School for two years before joining the South Dade News Leader in Homestead as a staff writer. In 1976, he moved on to The Sun-Tattler, the Scripps-Howard daily newspaper in Hollywood, Fla. There, he served first as a copy editor and garden editor, then as entertainment editor, reviewing films and stage plays and interviewing celebrities.

In 1984, Chuck joined the staff of the American Orchid Society as assistant editor of the society's publications when the organization moved its national headquarters to West Palm Beach. He eventually became editor of the AOS Bulletin and the Awards Quarterly.

In 1990, Chuck was hired as a copy editor for the Broward Edition of the *Miami Her*ald and worked in that capacity until he retired from the paper in 2009.

He still lives in Hollywood, where he strives to keep a small orchid collection alive.

Chuck is especially interested in the native orchids of South Florida and the Southern Appalachians, as well as in the New World orchid subtribe Laeliinae, which includes cattleyas and all their kin. He has written extensively about orchids for such publications as the AOS Bulletin (now Orchids), The Florida Orchidist, The Orchid Digest in California, England's Orchid Review, the Fairchild Tropical Garden Bulletin, and The Palmetto, the magazine of the Florida Native Plant Society.

In addition to his magazine articles, Chuck speaks frequently to orchid societies, garden clubs, native plant societies, and natural history groups about his favorite orchid topics, illustrating these talks primarily with his own photographs.

He has been a member of the American Orchid Society since 1976.



































