- 2. Absolutely NO INSECTS.
- 3. Your orchid must have a name.
- 4. It must be in the correct category. (Ask if you don't know.)
- 5. PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY the name of the Orchid and your name on the Registration Form.
- 6. Try to place your plant in an attractive container to enhance the orchids beauty.
- 7. Plants must be on the table before judging starts.
- PLANTS NOT MEETING THESE CRITERIA MAY BE DISQUALIFIED FROM JUDGING.

Speaker of the Month

Tom Kuligowski has been an orchid hobbyist for well over seventeen years. He has created and cared for three collections throughout that time period. Each collection being larger and healthier than the previous. As any other hobbyist, he is a firm believer that you learn from your mistakes. As you learn, you should see your collection not only grow in size (the mortality rate of your plants decreases), but you should also see an improvement in the quality and number of blooms in your collection.

Being a professional photographer, Tom has documented every aspect of his collections. He has created two programs over the last few years using the images that he's captured. The first program is that of the Angreacums he has specialized in growing since early 2000. The second, regarding an orchid's natural growing ability as epiphytes and/or lithophytes.

The second program entitled "Unusual and Natural Mounting" is his latest to be presented to various orchid societies. In it he discusses the reasons behind mounting, why mount, materials that work best and shows results he has achieved through his mounting techniques.

Tom will not be supplying a plant table, so members can be plants or divisions of plants to sell with 15% of the proceeds to be returned to the club as a sales commission.

At 2pm on the fourth Saturday of each month the AOS judges evaluate the orchids brought in for consideration.

Plant entry procedures:

- -Exhibitors should bring plants with complete information regarding name or cross.
- -They should fill out the entry form. Please include a clonal name in case of an award is given to a plant not previously awarded.

Orchid Tasks for September by Dr. Martin Motes

- Space plants to permit more air circulation
- Trim trees to permit more light and lessen wind load
- Clean up any dead leaves and organic matter
- Tidy up old pots or other objects on the ground
- Apply snail bait, lightly and frequently
- Spray quarternary ammonium chloride


Yellowing Leaves:

This is a normal aging process if only old leaves on backbulbs are involved. If newer leaves yellow and soften, look for: too much light, low temperature, lack of nitrogen (especially in bark) or loss of roots

Blackened Areas on Leaves:

The sudden appearance of brown then black areas on exposed surface of leaves on a bright, hot day, may be sunburn. Check shading: if blackened areas increase in size, it might be bacterial or fungal disease. Cut off diseased area, treat with fungicide such as natriphene, isolate plant, and dry it off.
