Hello all,

We have had a hot rainy summer. If you have been judiciously using pesticides and fungicides, you have probably been seeing much new growth and little disease in your collection. September is a rainy month with shorter drying daylight, so continue to use pesticides and fungicides (Physan, Consan) to avoid disease in your collection. be particularly vigilant of fungus and disease through this wet month until drier days arrive. Water early in the day to allow adequate drying.


